## UK Ring Sizing Chart

## INSTRUCTIONS

If you already have a fitting ring...

1. Print this page at $100 \%$. Do Not apply any scaling to the print.
2. When you have your print, measure this line with a ruler to check that the scale is accurate:
3. Place an existing ring over the template circles ensuring that you can see the whole circle underneath the ring when you look through the hole in the ring.
4. Note your size.

If you do not have a ring...

1. Cut a piece of paper in to a strip and wrap it around your ringer in the appropriate place.
2. When the paper is fitting snugly, tape it in to place and slide it off of your finger.
3. Simply take a ruler and measure the Diameter (the width) from one edge to the other edge of the paper.
4. Use the chart to match the Diameter to your result.

and $Z+6$. As we make each
